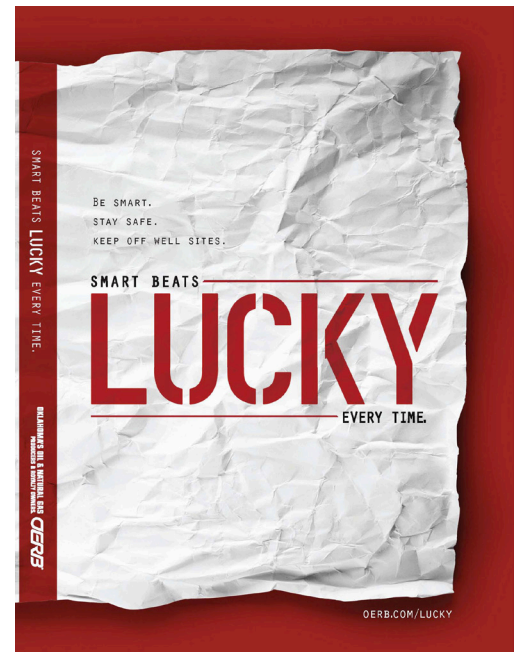




2019 Well Site Safety Poster / Instagram Story Contest

The OERB is seeking material created by Oklahoma students to promote well site safety to their peers. It is up to the student(s) to determine how they would like to communicate the message. This year's contest consists of creating a hand drawn or digital poster with a slogan **OR** an Instagram Story. This contest is part of the OERB's Well Site Safety Week, which is being held April 22-29, 2019.



Details:

Deadline for submissions: All entries must be submitted by March 29, 2019 at 11:59pm CST.

Students may enter as individuals or groups. Group size can be no larger than 5 students.

Two divisions: 7th-9th grade and 10th-12th grade.

One winner will be selected from each division.



The winning individual/group will receive a \$250 cash prize.



The winning teacher will receive \$250 to fund a DonorsChoose project.

Entry:

1. Create a hand drawn **OR** digital poster with a slogan **OR** an Instagram Story educating Oklahoma students about the importance of staying away from well sites and any oil field equipment.
2. A copy of the official entry form must be legibly completed and submitted with every entry.
3. The OERB reserves all rights to the entries submitted for the contest. All entries will become the property of the OERB for internal and external use.

Winners:

A panel of judges will decide the winning entries. All judges' decisions will be final.

Submissions are judged by message, creativity/originality, content and accuracy.

Winners and the faculty/teacher supervisor will be contacted by April 5, 2019.

Guidelines:

All entries must focus on educating Oklahoma students about the dangers of well sites and staying away from them. **Do not go to a well site to complete the project. Students trespassing on a well site will be disqualified from the contest. No exceptions!**

Students can use the background information provided and/or visit [OERB.com/safety](https://oerb.com/safety) to view additional factual information about well site safety.

All campaigns must be created solely by students under the guidance of a teacher or faculty member.

Students must submit **ONE** of the following:

OPTION 1 - Poster (hand drawn)

- Must be no smaller than 8 1/2" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 18".
- Posters must include your own original slogan.
- Media may include: marker, crayon, watercolor, ink, acrylic, or tempera painting. No pastels or chalk media will be accepted.
- Entries must be flat. Please do not fold, mat, mount, laminate, or frame entries.
- Posters must be on paper that will allow for duplication, framing and display.
- A copy of the official entry form must be legibly completed and securely attached (tape allowed) to the back of the entry.
- Entries must be submitted via mail. See entry form for details.

OPTION 2 - Poster (digital)

- Must be no smaller than 8 1/2" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 18".
- Posters must include your own original slogan.
- Entries must be submitted in PDF format.
- Entries must be submitted via email to teachers@oerb.com, using the subject line "Digital Poster Entry".
- A copy of the official entry form must be legibly completed and submitted with entry.

OPTION 3 - Instagram Story

- Create a unique Instagram Story that will educate the public about well site safety.
- Measurements must be 1080 pixels wide by 1920 pixels tall. Must be submitted as a .JPG file under 300 KB in size.
- You may use stock images, special fonts, stickers, emojis, etc. to make your story unique.
- You may only submit up to 8 photos max, in chronological order, to tell your story.
- Please use photos only - no videos or boomerangs.
- No inappropriate or offensive content.
- All graphics must be 100 percent original.
- If the winning entry is an Instagram Story it will be shared on the OERB's Instagram account, @oerbok. Please provide your Instagram handle if you would like to be tagged in the post.
- A copy of the official entry form must be legibly completed and submitted with entry.
- Entries must be submitted via email to teachers@oerb.com. Use the subject line "Instagram Story Entry".
